

What to Wear to Orientation

Business casual attire is appropriate for orientation. For clinical staff, scrubs of any color will be permitted during orientation. Once you are in your department you will be expected to wear your designated scrub color.

We highly recommend you bring a light sweater or jacket to orientation as the classroom may be cooler than what you prefer.

Office Environment Dress Code

- Business professional pants, suits, slacks, trousers, kakis, and corduroy.
- Professional business shirts/sweaters, button-down or pullover shirts with collars, modest tops, dress shirts.
- Suit like jackets, blazers, sports coats, embroidered MRHC Logo.
- Business professional shoes, loafers, leather shoes, clogs (clinical and food service areas only), work boots (department specific uniform only), athletic shoes (clinical). Closed-toe dress shoes and peep-toe shoes.
- Modest dresses and skirts. Leggings worn with dresses, skirts, and business professional tunics.
